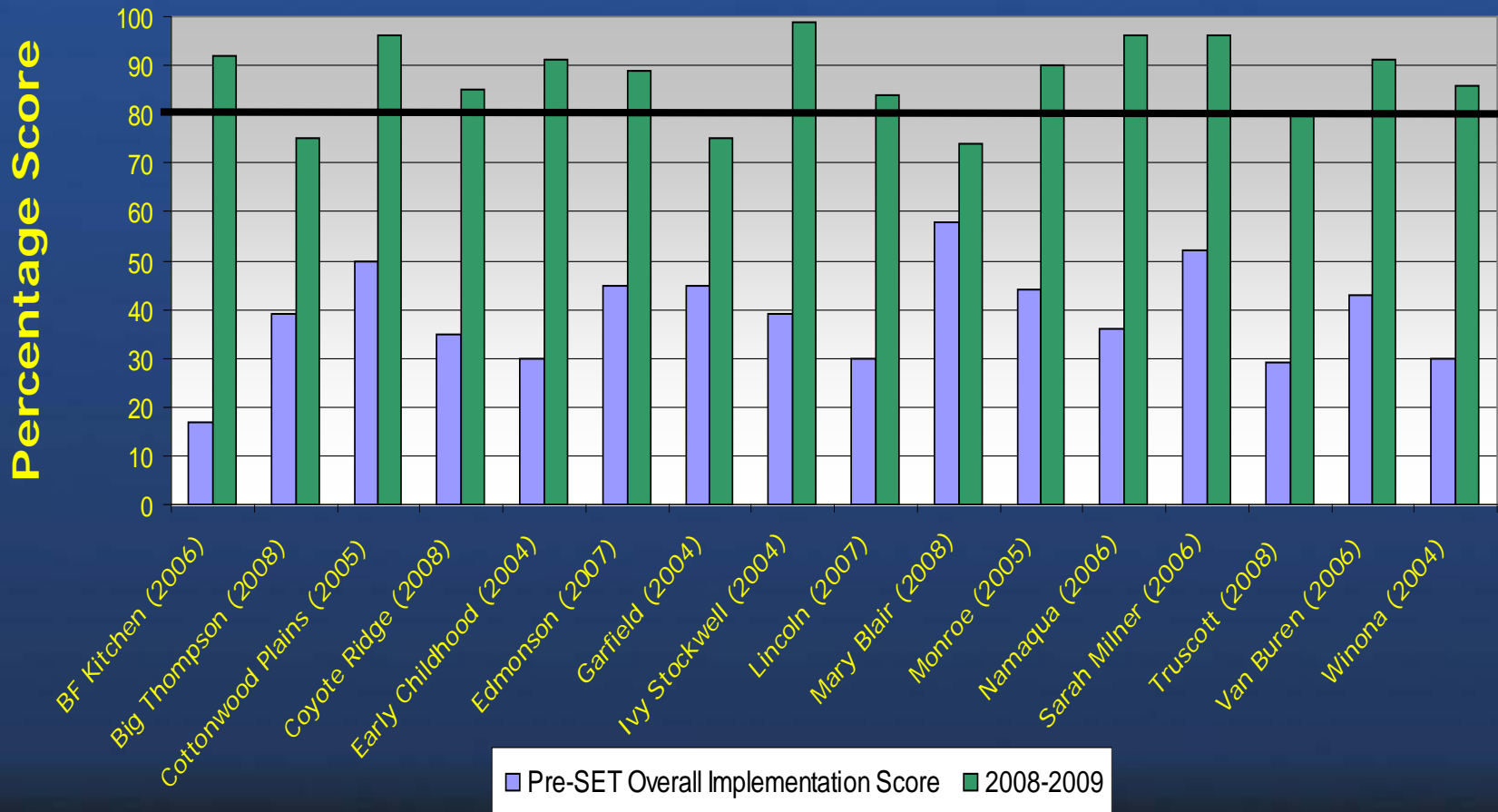

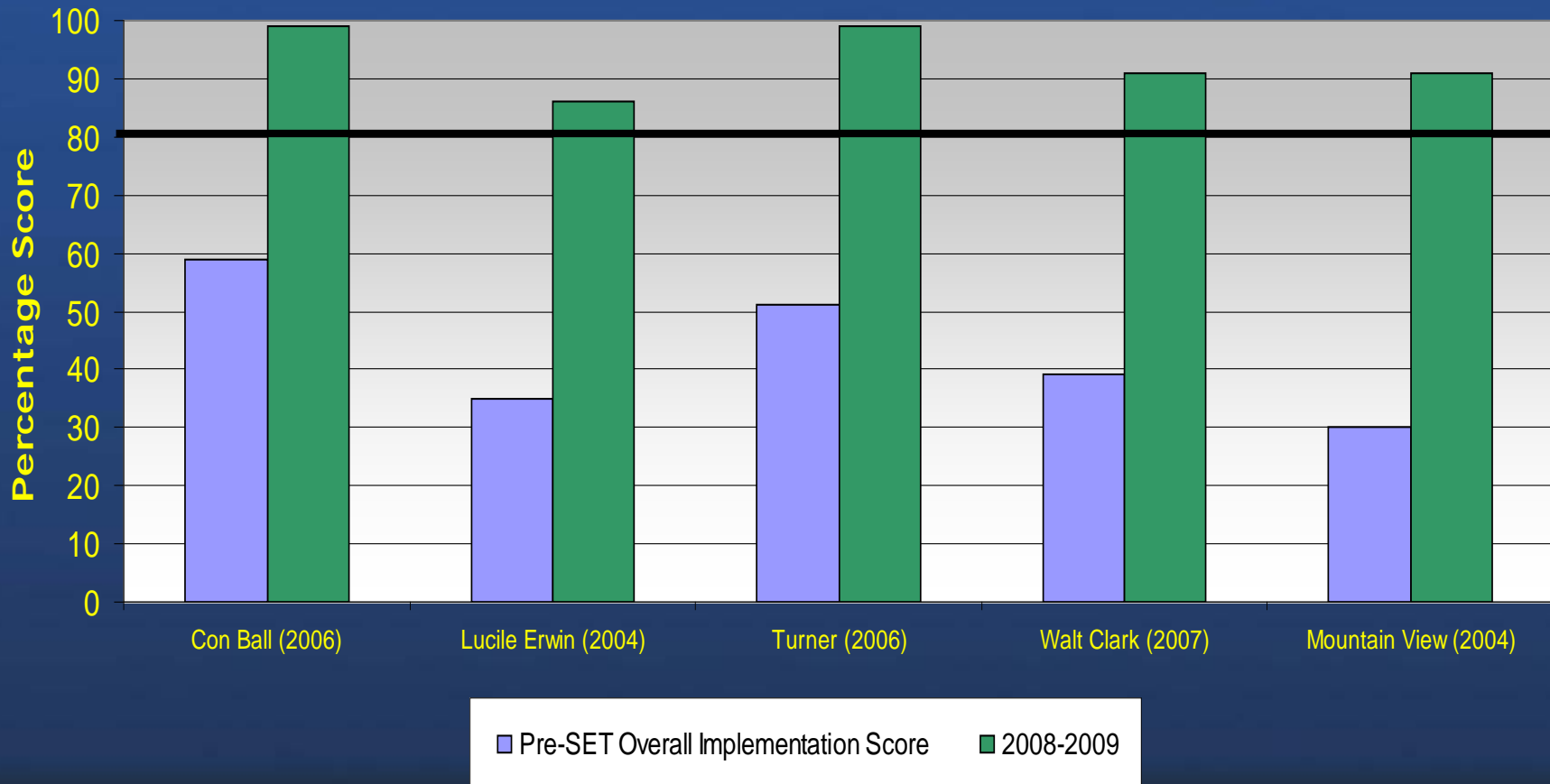

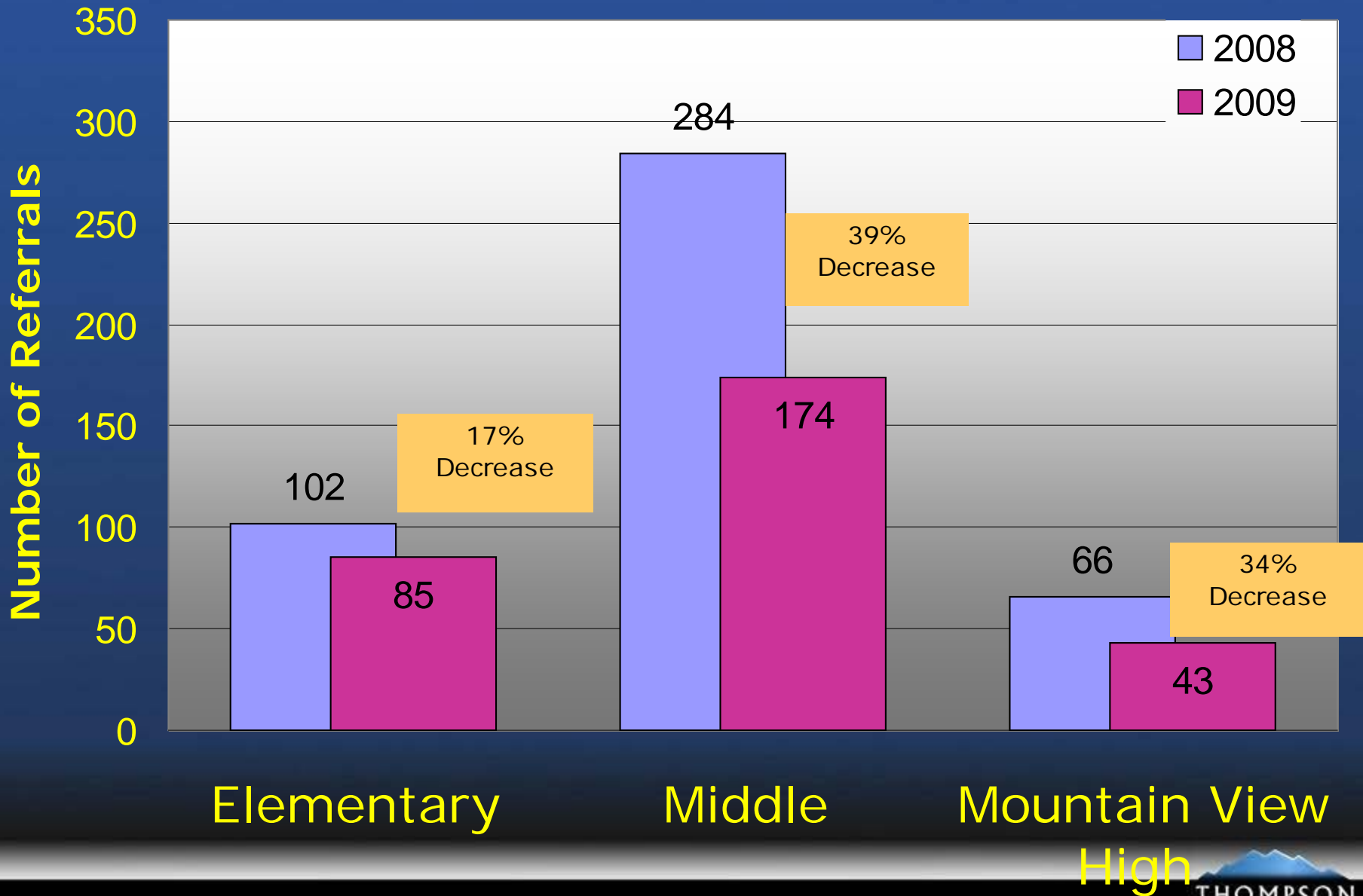
Overall Implementation of PBS from Initial Year of Implementation Compared to 2008-2009 for District Elementary Schools



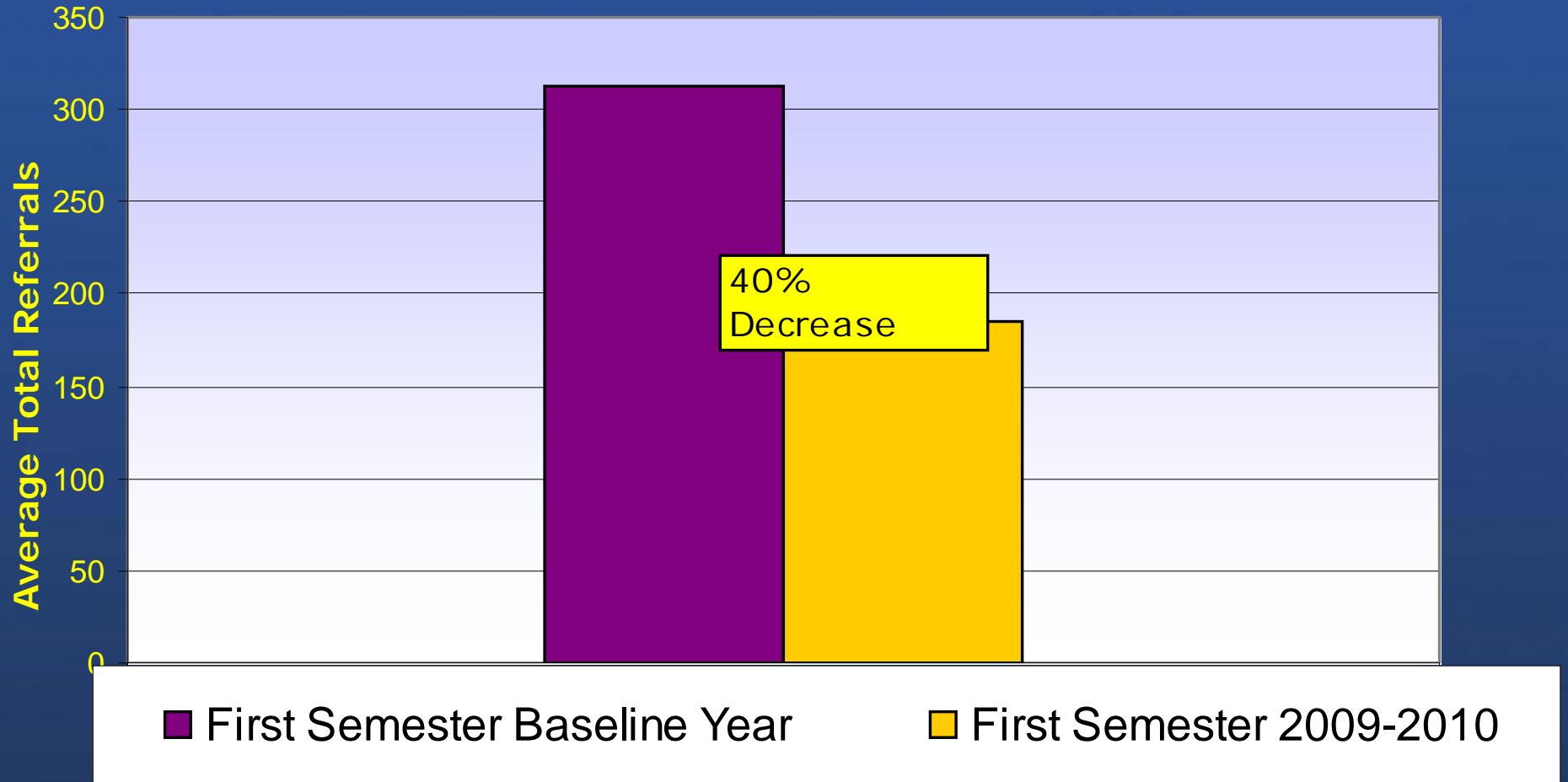
Overall Implementation of PBS Initial Year of Implementation Compared to 2008-2009 Secondary Schools



First Semester Office Discipline Referrals for Defiance or Disrespect for 2008 & 2009

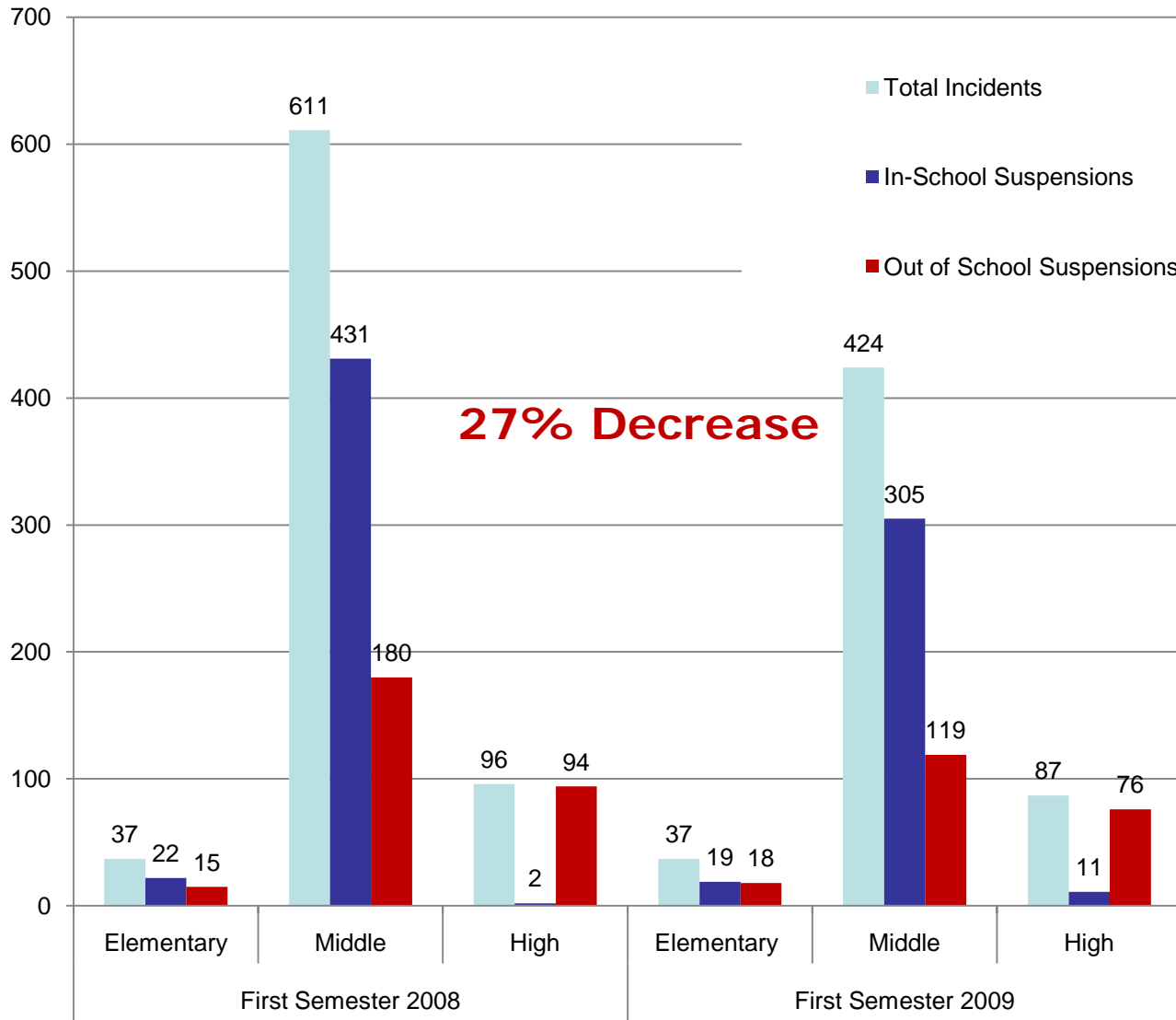


Discipline Referrals for Elementary Schools in Thompson School District

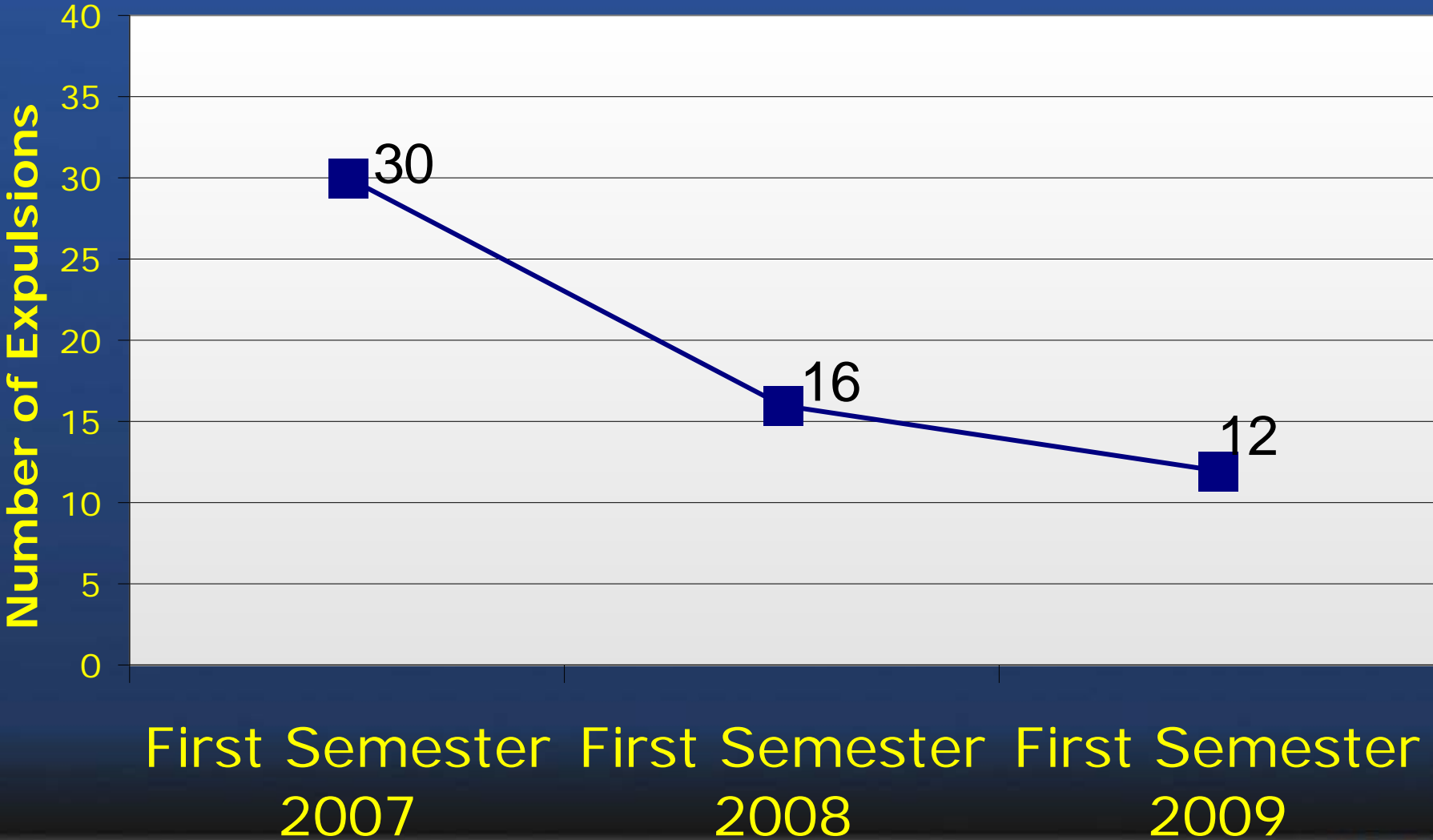


Total and Type of Suspension for the District

Number of Suspensions

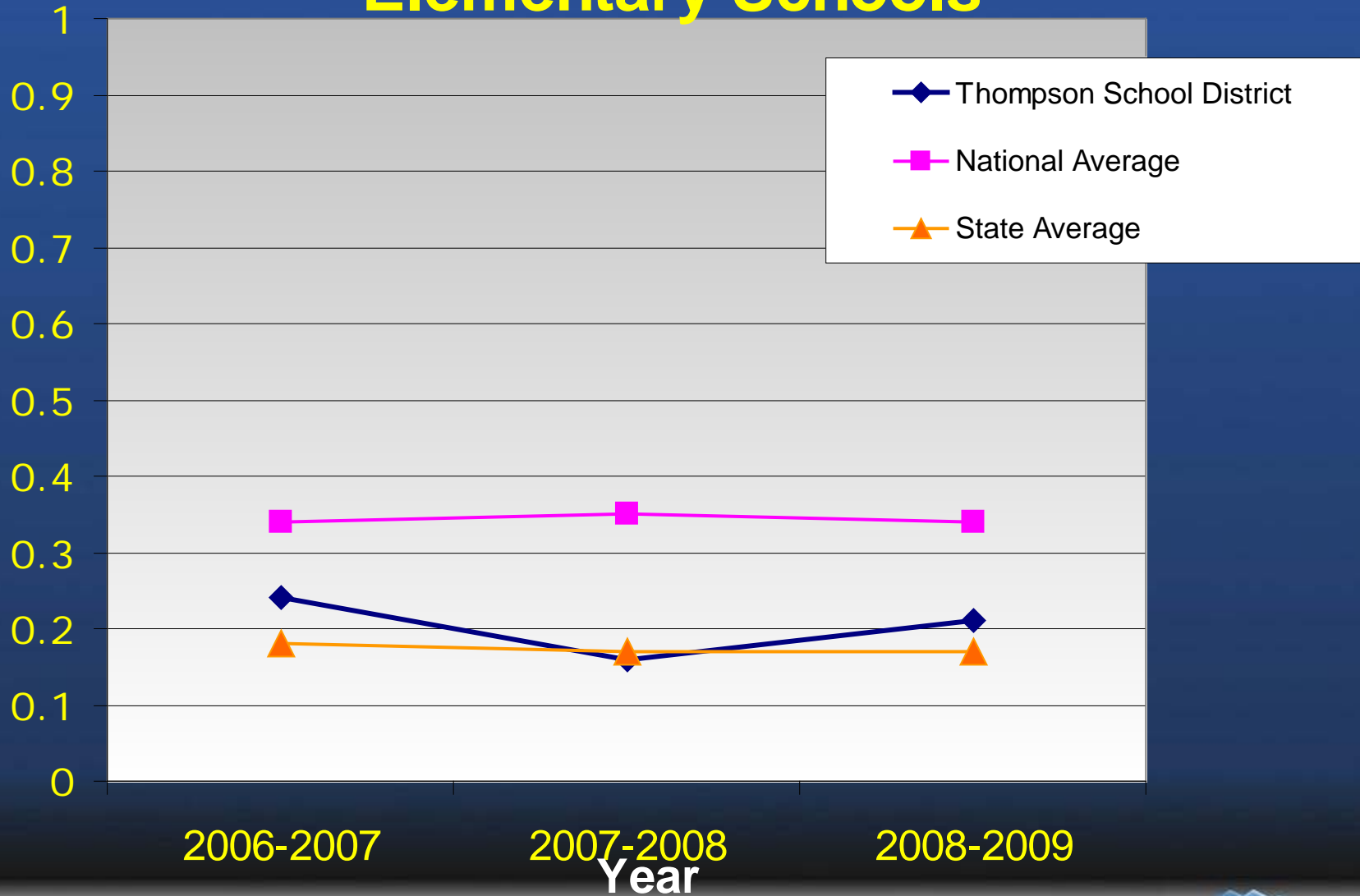


Expulsions During the First Semester of the School Year Across 2007-09 for the District

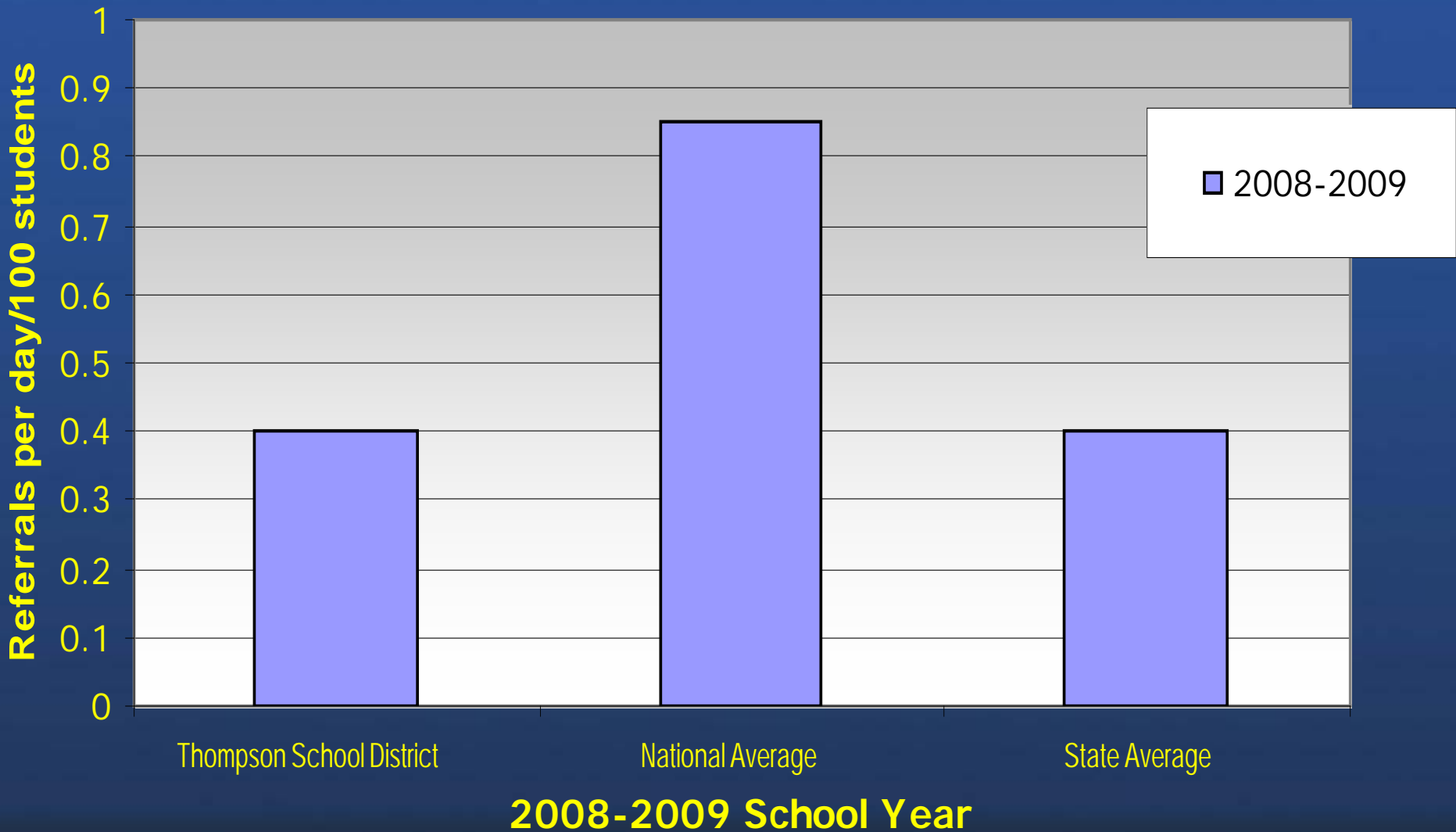


Average Daily Office Referral Rate for Elementary Schools
